CESAR ON CAM	<p>CESAR: Remember, all family members need to establish pack leadership – no matter what age!</p> <p>Let's review some tips for overexcitement:</p>
CHYRONS & EXAMPLES	<p>CESAR:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Often, these dogs require more exercise. - Always supervise your dog when he is on the treadmill. - Talk to your vet about what type of collar to use for different exercise activities. - Do not reinforce unwanted behaviors. If your dog is engaging in attention-seeking behavior, ignore it!
CHYRON: Problems on the Walk	CESAR: And now let's look at the most common misbehavior that dog owners face: problems on the walk!
CESAR ON CAM	<p>CESAR: One problem on the walk is pulling on the leash.</p> <p>Taffy the Beagle took her owner Tracie for walks, so Tracie called me in to get this taffy pull under control!</p>
TRACIE AND TAFFY EXITING THE HOUSE CESAR IN BUBBLE	CESAR: The problems began before the walk even started. Taffy is in an excited state, and she's the first one out the door.
- TAFFY PULLING TRACIE ON THE WALK - TAFFY BARKING AT ANOTHER DOG	CESAR: There's no question who's controlling the walk. Taffy is still out in front. She's the leader. And she's letting everyone else know it.
